### CMS is waiving PECOS Applications fees?

- Both new and revalidations
- Perfect for Pharmacies looking to start an Immunization Program
- Great to start or restart DMEPOS dispensing

### DMEPOS products had a paperwork reduction?

- Less items requiring medical practitioner signatures
- For most items you only need to collect 3 items: a Prescription, Detailed Written Description (which pharmacy can complete), and Receipt of Goods & Services

### USP <800> went into full effect March 12th?

- USP <795> & USP <797> appeal over beyond use dating; with testing requirements and shipping to and from labs, a 90 day supply is more like a 45-60 day supply
- A previous version of <795> and <797> are now in place
- Other regulatory agency such as OSHA, FDA, EPA, and state environmental agency's will also oversee segments of USP <800>

### There is a new Draft NIOSH list pending?

- Open for public comment through December
- Drugs will be moving tables, new notes, and guidance
- USP will be officially in charge of Hazardous Drug usage
- Table 2 and Table 3's should be allowed in automation systems, robots, and pill counters

### You can get a temporarily enrollment CLIA waiver for COVID-19 testing?

- Refer to CMS supplement to enroll now
- This is a temporary waiver during the pandemic, you will need to complete a full application to continue to test post pandemic
